It has been the flagship journal of China in computational mathematics in the past three decades.

JCM's 2013 SCI impact factor is 1.049. It is ranked 40/299 in mathematics and 73/250 in applied mathematics.

JCM's 2012 SCI impact factor is 0.851. It is ranked 61/296 in mathematics and 100/247 in applied mathematics.

JCM's 2011 SCI impact factor is 0.978. It is ranked 42/288 in mathematics and 75/248 in applied mathematics.

JCM is sponsored by the Institute of Computational Mathematics and Scientific/Engineering Computing (ICMSEC) of the Chinese Academy of Sciences.
